January 21, 2024 General Meeting Program

On January 21st at the Middleton Place Clubhouse, we welcomed Historic Restoration Specialist Derrick Tickle and his young grandson, Oli, who shared images and explanations of Derrick's restoration efforts at the Biltmore House and two other prominent Asheville public buildings. We shared a pot luck meal

and also thanked Ron Partin for his many years of dedicated efforts in producing the Club's newsletter.

Tickle is originally from England and trained in historic restoration techniques there. He moved to the US in the late 70's when offered a teaching position created by a partnership formed by AB Tech and the Biltmore House.

This master craftsman shared the inside restoration story of two prominent Asheville public buildings as well as the Biltmore House. He also explained techniques used to restore interiors and the challenges presented in this type of work. His former students continue working across the country on major restoration projects.

Sadly, the restoration training program was discontinued in 2008 and today there is a shortage in our area of these talented, skilled craftspeople. This was an outstanding program, and all of us joined in thanking Mr. Tickle for his presentation and the skills he brought to our community.
