#### Gerri Gurbuz – A Visit to Tunisia – June 30 – July 7, 2024

Last June, Iceland --with glaciers, floating icebergs and volcanoes; this June, a sharp contrast with Tunisia's desert, oases, and seventeenth century mountain Berber dwellings.

This small nation, wedged between Algeria and Libya is rich in a variety of culture and antiquity, when Carthage rivaled Rome for dominance. The Bardo Museum claims (I believe accurately) the world's largest collection of Roman mosaics in splendid condition.
