FFWNC Grant Fund

Thanks to a generous donation from a member, a grant fund was established last year for journey scholarships, \$1,000 for international club-to-club journeys and \$500 for domestic club-to-club journeys.

The application form is simple to complete, and no personal financial information will be required to apply for these grants. Applicants must have been a FFWNC member for one (1) year and have participated in club service (i.e., served on the Board, served on a committee, helped with journeys, etc.) Applicants may apply once every three years.

There is a 3-member committee that will review all applications and make award decisions. At this time, there is one outbound journey to Western Michigan to take place in September, 2025, for which applications will be accepted.

Applications are to be submitted to Journey Grant Committee, P.O. Box 384, Hendersonville, NC 28793.

This is a wonderful opportunity to help members with the rising cost of travel.
