From The Archives



Friendship Force of Western North Carolina (FFWNC) was founded in 1979. Governor Jim Hunt was asked by President Jimmy and Rosalyn Carter to organize Friendship Force in North Carolina. Marie Colton, a state legislator from Asheville at the time, was our founding president. She passed away in 2018 at the age of 95. [Marie Colton Obituary](#)

Since our club's founding, more than 3,000 people in Western North Carolina have participated in journeys either as hosts for foreign guests or as citizen ambassadors overseas experiencing cultures and countries across Europe, Central Asia, Southeast Asia, Australia, and New Zealand, as well as Central and South America.

Quarterly Book Club - Harriet Hilton

Our book club meets quarterly in January, April, July, and October. On a rotating basis, a member picks a book for the meeting, leads the discussion, and sets the location for the event. Sometimes we meet in homes and sometimes at local coffee spots. Meetings are usually 1:30 to 3 pm. Selection of a book is normally based around travel, the global impact of peace and conflict management, or cultural issues. Our last book was ***The Rose Code*** by Kate Quinn, a heart-stopping World War II historical fiction novel of three female code breakers at Bletchley Park and the spy they must root out after the war is over.

The next meeting is April 24 at Larry Harvey's house. We will read ***Miss Brenda and the Loveladies*** by Brenda Spahn, which is about previously incarcerated women and their journeys and struggles to succeed once released.
